Date: 20th August, 2026

Time of issue: 1800 hours IST (evening)

Weather forecast Bulletin for Gujarat state and Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu based on 1200 UTC observation/chart and available NWP model outputs dated 20.08.2026

Weather realised during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hours IST of 20.08.2026

- Rainfall occurred at isolated places over South Gujarat region and Saurashtra; weather was dry over North Gujarat region and Kutch.

Synoptic Situation:

- Morning's **Well-Marked Low-Pressure Area** over northeast Madhya Pradesh & neighbourhood persisted over the same region at 1430 hrs IST of today, the 20th August, 2026. The associated cyclonic circulation extending upto 7.6 km above mean sea level tilting southwards with height persists.
- The **Monsoon Trough** at mean sea level continues to pass through Amritsar, Najibabad, Fatehgarh, Hardoi, centre of Well-Marked Low-Pressure Area over northeast Madhya Pradesh & neighbourhood, Digha and thence southeastwards to Northeast Bay of Bengal.
- **South-westerly to Westerly** winds are prevailing at lower levels over the region.

Light to moderate rain/thundershowers very likely **at isolated** places in all districts of North Gujarat region namely Banaskantha, Vav-Tharad, Patan, Mehsana, Sabarkantha, Gandhinagar, Aravalli, Kheda, Ahmedabad, Anand, Panchmahal, Dahod and Mahisagar; **at a few** places in the districts of South Gujarat region namely Narmada, Surat, Dang, Tapi, Navsari, Valsad and in Daman, Dadra and Nagar Haveli; **at isolated** places in the districts of South Gujarat region namely Vadodara, Chhota Udepur, Bharuch; **at isolated** places in all the districts of Saurashtra -Kutch namely Surendranagar, Rajkot, Jamnagar, Porbandar, Junagadh, Amreli, Bhavnagar, Morbi, Dwarka, Gir Somnath, Botad, Kutch and in Diu.

DAY-6

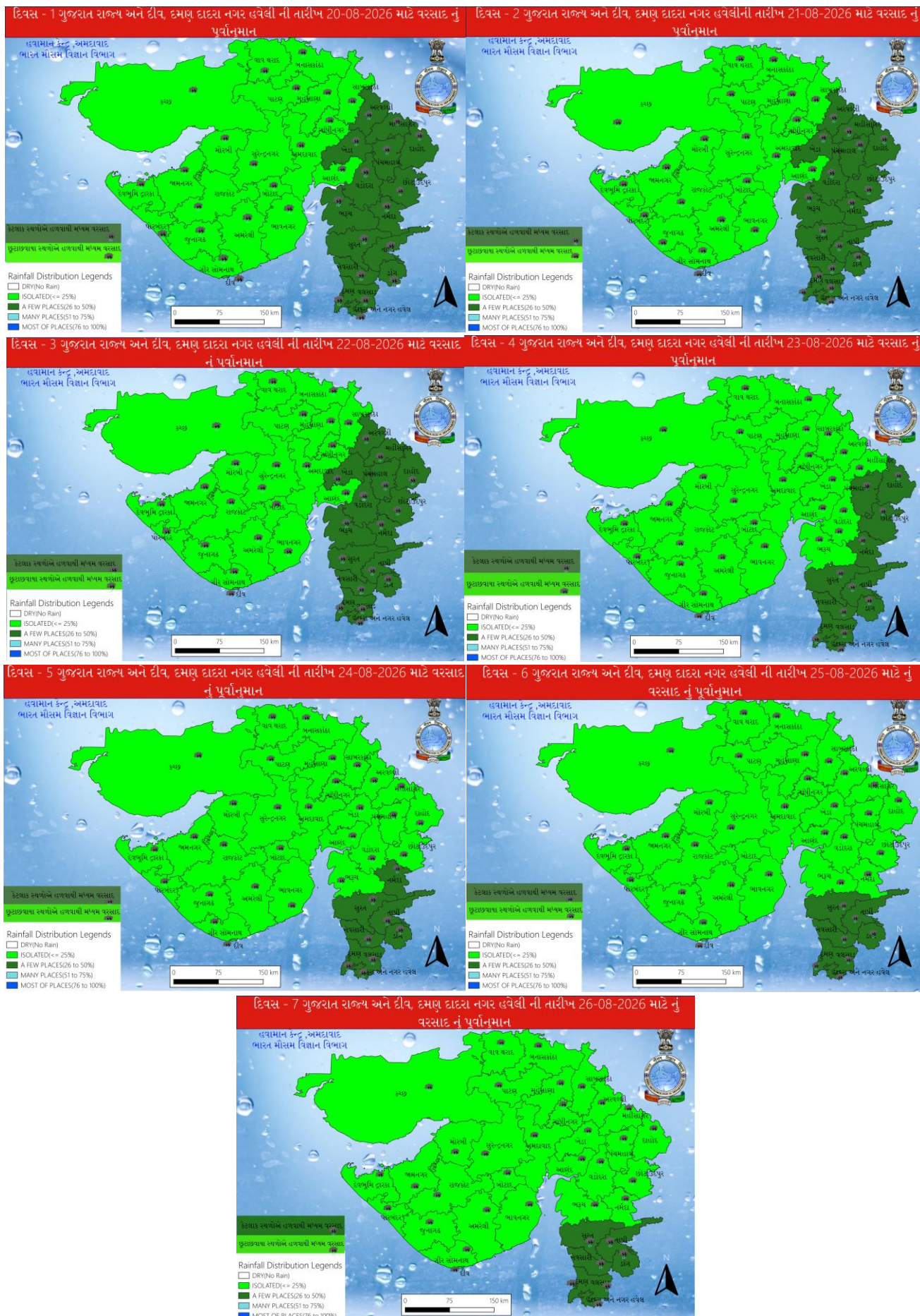

Spatial Distribution of Rainfall	Descriptive term used	Criteria for observed/forecast weather
Dry	Dry	No station reported/expecting rainfall
Isolated	One or two Places	≤25% of stations get/expected to get rainfall
Scattered	At a few Places	(26–50) % of stations get/expected to get rainfall
Fairly Widespread	At many Places	(51–75) % of stations get/expected to get rainfall
Wide spread	At most places	(76–100) % of stations get/expected to get rainfall

Terminology for intensity of 24 hour accumulated rainfall: -

Terminology	Rainfall (mm)	Rainfall (cm)
Very light rainfall	Trace -2.4	--
Light rainfall	2.5-15.5	Upto 1
Moderate rainfall	15.6-64.4	2-6
Heavy Rainfall	64.5- 115.5	7-11
Very Heavy Rainfall	115.6-204.4	12-20
Extremely heavy rainfall	Greater than or equal to 204.5 mm	21 cm or more
Exceptionally Heavy Rainfall	When the rainfall observed is a value near about the highest recorded rainfall at or near the station for the month or the season. However, this term will be used only when the actual rainfall amount exceeds 12 cm.

Term	Probability of occurrence
Unlikely	Less than 25%
Likely	25% to 50%
Very likely	50% to 75 %
Most likely	more than 75%
